FaceTime comes with all new Apple Mac computers, so if you have one chances are you'll be ready to call us for a video chat straight away.

Skype is simple and free, and works with almost all computers (and a lot of mobile phones, too.) Download it from www.skype.com to get started, and follow their instructions to register and get your 'Skype name' - this is what other people will use to call you.
